February 7th "A fun day of Introduction of new projects, **or**
An opportunity to work on a previous project."

10am to 12 "Introduction to Japanese Braiding"

In this class the beginner will make an 8 warp braided choker,

"Silken Waves", in hand-dyed silk, a pendant feature, and completed with metal end caps and clasp.

Returning students can choose either "Silken Waves" or "Diamond Dayz" which has 16 warps and a diamond pattern worked into it.

Class: \$25

Kit: \$40 (Includes a Kumihimo Disk and all materials)

Kit: \$20 for "Diamond Dayz" Kit.

February 7th - Afternoon:

12 to 2pm "Introduction to Flower Making", **or**

bring along your "Flower Wrap" or "Funky Flower Scarf" to work on.

Learn to make flowers to enhance knitted projects, or as fun decorations for gifts.

Class: \$25

Starter Kit: \$28 (Includes Flower Motif Disk Set and a selection of threads)

February 14th

10am to 12 Braiding Workshop "Braided Belt" - Day 1

Choose either a combination of Berroco Seduce and Mica, or hand-dyed silk.

In this class, you will learn a fun flat braid using 8 warps.

Workshop: \$75 (3 day workshop)

Silk Kit: \$78 (Includes Silk, beads, & bobbins)

Berroco Kit: \$45 (Includes 1 each Berroco Mica & Seduce, beads & bobbins)

It would be advantageous if Berroco yarn was cut into 5 meter lengths prior to this class.

Disk: \$20

NB: Kits do not include extra beads for the tassel as students can choose their own.

February 21st

10am to 12 Braiding Workshop "Braided Belt" - Day 2

Learn a new fine braid using only 4 threads.

February 28th

10am to 12 Braiding Workshop "Braided Belt" - Day 3

Assemble the belt using an interlacing technique. Finish with a beaded tassel.

You are welcome to bring along your own beads to enhance your tassel.

Things to bring:

Flower Power Classes:

- Size 3.5 or 4 Crochet hook (for 1st Class)
- Size 5 Crochet hook for "Funky Flower Scarf"
- Large eye tapestry needle
- Tape measure
- Scissors
- Small cushion to support "Funky Flower Scarf" while working on it.

Kumihimo Classes:

- Scissors
- Tape Measure
- Beading tray or mat (for Day 2 & 3)
